



Admissions and Recruitment Considerations for BAISD EDGE Early Middle College Students

- Students can only enter the program in 11th grade. However, planning can begin when students enter high school.
- GPA should be a consideration. At least a 2.0 is recommended.
- Assessment results, such as the PSAT, should be reviewed.
- EDP goals should align with intended EMC programming.
- A pattern of positive behavior and attendance should be evident.
- When applying for EMC enrollment, factors such as extracurricular participation, employment, and other commitments are important considerations.
- Past success in college-level courses is a positive indicator.
- The student will need to have access to transportation for the classes held on the college campus.
- As part of the application process, a conference will be held with the student and parents to discuss readiness, and two recommendations will need to be submitted with the application.
- The Accuplacer assessment will be administered to determine appropriate placement.
- This is an excellent opportunity for first-generation college students, economically disadvantaged students, and students facing adverse environments to engage in postsecondary education with support and guidance.
