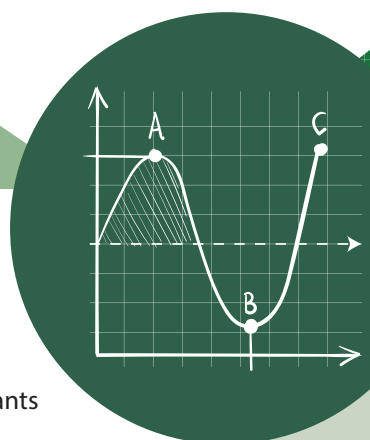
DESCRIPTION

- Access embedded tools to support diverse learners (e.g., text-to-speech, free response uploads)
