Join us for a dynamic two-day Reproductive Health Bootcamp, designed for health and physical education teachers, school counselors, and educators responsible for delivering reproductive health education in schools. Whether you're new to teaching this content or looking to enhance your instruction, this training will provide valuable insights, practical tools, and collaborative learning experiences to bring back to your classroom.

Day 1: HIV Prevention – Empowering Educators for Effective Instruction

On the first day, educators will focus on HIV prevention, learning evidence-based strategies to teach students about transmission, risk reduction, and stigma. Participants will explore:

- Current HIV trends and prevention methods, including PrEP and condoms
- Michigan laws related to HIV education
- Inclusive and trauma-informed teaching approaches

Day 2: Comprehensive Sex Education – Effective Strategies for the Classroom

The second day will cover a broader range of sex education topics, including:

- Age-appropriate instruction and Michigan's A-K law
- Teaching puberty, consent, healthy relationships, and contraception
- Implementing inclusive and trauma-informed practices

Using a skills-based model (introduction, explanation, modeling, and application), educators will practice answering challenging student questions and explore strategies for fostering a supportive and accurate learning environment. The session will conclude with action planning to help educators implement engaging and effective sex education in their schools.
